MINUTES OF THE ROAD MATTERS COMMITTEE MEETING OF LLANCARFAN COMMUNITY COUNCIL HELD VIA ZOOM ON 15TH APRIL 2021 at 7pm

RM1504/005 To receive apologies for absence.
There were no apologies received.

RM1504/006 To receive any declarations of interests.
There were no declarations of interest.

RM1504/007 Update on Llandcadle to Aberogwen Farm road repairs and improvements

Mr Michael Clogg was emailed regarding this matter. Last correspondence received from Mr Clogg was in October 2020.

It has not been resurfaced, but the potholes have been filled.

Following the meeting at the crossroads, Cllr G Kemp to ask for an update on any planned resurfacing or planned kerb work.

RM1504/008 Action on road flooding south of Llandcadle

There is no culvert there and the field is higher than the road. When the men cleared the roads within the last 3 months, they informed Cllr J Lott that it would require a JCB to dig out all the mud not just loose debris. If they took a JCB into the field, it would take it away. The field belongs to the castle.

There has been water in dingle head for months. It would be easy to open the bank and solve the problem. They are no longer inspected on a regular basis.

It floods and you cannot get through without a tractor or 4x4 and it floods at Middlecross so you cannot get out that way either.

ACTION – Cllr A Rees will respond to Michael Clogg asking for them to make a ditch

In Walterston, just north of the houses there is a drain there which is blocked. It needs jetting and Cllr T Thomas does not have the facilities; Cllr T Thomas did arrange someone from the Vale Council there to do it with the jetting equipment but they did not turn up.

RM1504/009 Flooding and general deterioration of Brewers Lane, Llantrithyd.

The Vale Council did say that they were going to resurface about 3 years ago.

From top road into Llantrithyd, it floods at the bottom. The quarry pumps out and it comes along Nant Llantrithyd and past the brook and past Brook Cottage. It is a low point in Llantrithyd, and the drains are blocked, the culverts are blocked, and it has been flooded four times this year so far. People have been inconvenienced but houses have not been flooded.

The Vale council have been informed.

RM1504/010 Potholes on road from Walterston to Five Mile Lane.

These potholes have been reported and subsequently dealt with.
